Meet and Greet in Arrivals Hall: ITC staff and local representative, **Diplomatic Operations**Visit to the **Mosque of Mohammed Ali** in the **Citadel of Cairo**Transfer across Cairo to Giza and the **Steigenberger Pyramids Hotel** for dinner and overnight [3N]
